On the day you come for advising, you will stop by the ChE office (3307 Patrick Taylor Hall), where you will pick up your paperwork and be advised. There will always be at least one professor there to see you. You do not have to email a professor for an appointment time—you will simply see whichever professor is on call that day. After you are advised, your flag will be lifted before the first day of the registration cycle, which begins April 1 at 5 pm. With 54 advising hours set over two weeks, you should not have any trouble seeing an advisor at a time that is convenient for you. Come by 3307 Patrick Taylor Hall to get your paperwork and get advised one day between March 12 and March 23. If you wait to be advised many of the courses you want may be full.
