<p>This revised course is based upon the current edition of the National Fire Protection Association’s 101 Life Safety Code and is designed to equip students responsible for building code inspections within their authority having jurisdiction (AHJ) with the knowledge and skills necessary for effective life safety compliance.</p> <p>Students that are new to the Life Safety Code should attend all three classes while experienced students may choose to select the classes of their choice. The course covers construction features and occupancy types, protection methods and systems, and operational features designed to provide safety from fire, smoke, and panic.
