Required Application Materials - 1st Year and Transfer Students

1. **PAGE RESUME:** A single page resume that highlights the creative work that you have done as well as activities and/or relevant employment.
2. **LEADERSHIP/COLLABORATION ASSESSMENT:** This is an industry in which the ability to lead and the ability to collaborate are key. In no more than 500 words, relate a time when you were in a leadership position and how you used that position to encourage cooperation and collaboration with those around you. We are looking for your unique insights and your ability to tell us an engaging story.
3. **CREATIVE SUBMISSION:** A creative work that shows your ability for visual storytelling and imaginative thought. Choose ONE of the following:
 - a. Film or video – live action/narrative/documentary/animation – Can be a single or multiple works that add up to a minimum of 3 minutes and a maximum of 15 minutes run time. Video of sports or staged theatre performance is not acceptable. Your video should be a self-contained work that represents yourself and your artistic endeavors to the best of your ability. Please make your contribution to the work clear. Please submit as a link to Vimeo, Youtube, Googledrive, etc.
 - i. Very short form (Vine/TikTok, etc.) are acceptable provided they are compiled and presented according to the rules above.
 - b. A creative writing sample of at least 5 pages and no more than 48 pages. You may submit a screenplay, pilot, or short screenplay. It must be a complete work (not part of a larger piece). If submitting screenplay, it must be in proper screenplay format.
