

LSU FALL 2024 STUDENT ENROLLMENT HIGHLIGHTS

PURPOSE

This report provides insight on LSU's Fall 2024 census date student headcount enrollment, including students enrolled on the census date of LSU Online's 2024 First-Fall Module.

DATA COLLECTION OVERVIEW

Data for this report are obtained from student records files created on September 16, 2024.

DATA HIGHLIGHTS

All headcounts include on-campus enrollment plus LSU Online students enrolled in the Fall 2024 first module. In addition, graduate-level enrollment includes professional Law & Veterinary Medicine students.

NEW FRESHMEN HIGHLIGHTS

- The 2024 full-time, first-year cohort totals 7,912, the largest in LSU history
- ACT Composite is 27.0, the highest ever
- High School Weighted Transcript GPA is 3.83, the highest ever
- Percent Female is 62.2%, the highest ever
- Percent Black/African American is 26.8%, the highest ever
- Percent Hispanic is 11.9%, the highest ever
- Percent First-Generation is 32.3%
- Enrollment by Geographic Origin:
 - Louisiana: 59.6%Other State: 39.4%Other Country: 1.0%
- Ogden Honors College:
 - Cohort total is 987
 - ACT Composite is 30.8
 - High School Weighted Transcript GPA is 4.27

New Freshmen Notes:

Beginning with the Fall 2021 cohort, test scores only include students who elected to have test scores considered during the admissions and scholarship decision process. Beginning Fall 2023, the ACT composite is based on superscore.
