SPAN 3074 Advanced Readings on Hispanic-American Civilization (3). Prereq.: SPAN 3010.

SPAN 4146 Latin American Literature (3). Prereq.: One literature course in Spanish at the 3000 level and permission of department

SPAN 4915 Independent research in Spanish-American literature (3).

Cost of the Program: approx. \$3,700 (I am still working on the budget. L. Martins)

The Program Fee includes:

- Córdoba Airport to downtown Córdoba (one way trip [arrival in Arg])
- Córdoba city tour
- Jesuit ranch / Che Guevara Museum
- Museums, cultural sites
- La Cumbrecita
- Mendoza trip/The Andes Mountains/ski resort (bus tickets, lodging/breakfast included)
- Buenos Aires trip (bus tickets, lodging and breakfast included + dinner and Tango Show)
- Room and Board (two meals a day: Breakfast and dinner) in Córdoba**
- Medical insurance**

NOT included in the program fee:

-Airfare from USA to Argentina

-The summer tuition fee at LSU.

(You must be enrolled in 6 credit hours in order to participate in the program.)

Application Deadline: March 23, 2018

Although the application deadline is **March 23**, you are advised to register early in order to secure a spot in the program. The program will fill on a first come, first served basis from those who meet the eligibility requirements. A \$500 deposit will be placed on your LSU billing statement at the time that you apply to the program. Students at other universities must send in a check or money order (made payable to "Louisiana State University") for the \$500 deposit along with their applications. This deposit is nonrefundable after **February 2**. After that date, you will be responsible for making payments on your study abroad program, even if you do not go on the program. The amount that you will owe is based on the date on which you withdraw.
