- President Report
 - Notes from SGA Forum about OLOL
 - Overall message is that current level of care will be continued or will improve.
 - Will continue providing gender affirming care: SHC refers out to specialist for initial HRT assessment & treatment plan, but SHC does maintenance once plan is in place.
 - Plan to expand imbedded therapist to other colleges (currently in Honor College & Law Center)
 - Plan to increase diversity in hiring and expand staff training related to cultural competency and DEI
 - All patients have the right to be referred to doctor of your choice
 - Religious imagery in SHC
 - OLOL logo with the Tau symbol (that includes a cross)
 - Altered practices including no prayer before meetings
 - Will honor requirements of LSU
 - No religious pictures or crucifixes in SHC
 - How will you address students who are afraid to use SHC because of OLOL religious affiliation.
 - Messaging to reassure
 - Religious affiliation will not impact care
 - Feedback:
 - Every first visit of the semester results in feedback form/survey
 - Email Julie with concerns/feedback
 - LGBTQ+ Caucus- In the event that a service is not available at SHC, will referral be made to screened providers?
 - Mechanism does not exist to 'screen' providers
 - SHC has internal referral guide kept by case manager
 - VP Mark Bieger in the Office of Strategy and Strategic Planning has postponed, but a survey to come regarding what we want him to know.

 - Saturday afternoon; Celeste Payne at Chortazo Art Gallery, guided acrylic on canvas art party, we can bring our own food and drink
