Treasurer Report

- \$2865 in account
 - Department expense reports makes it difficult to access our funds
 - Alternative options for a caucus bank account
 - Foundation account is easier to get money out of but minimum balance of \$5000
 - LaCarte card might make things a little easier
 - Looking into solutions for more immediate reimbursements
 - o Recommendation for fundraiser: crawfish boil to raise needed balance as possibility
 - Action Steps for Friends of the Library / Book Bazaar
 - Writing a letter to FOTL to start dialogue about issue to understand how and why shelving issues are made; offer solution; their response will direct what action the Caucus takes next
 - Librarian member: FOTL has had the same grouping for years, absence of young adult section
 - Caucus member: First time kids' books were found in this section; Everything LGBTQ has been in the Adult section
 - LSU Libraries Diversity Committee is waiting to hear what happens when our Caucus reaches out to FOTL; Library Diversity Committee member wants to ensure this is a priority for the library and take action in educating FOTL

- Caucus engagement for this legislative session
 - Thank you to Sophie for helping to keep us informed
 - "Pleasure Activism" as way to help sustain us as we take on these challenges
 - General Discussion: How are you feeling? Are you feeling alone or overwhelmed in wanting to act?
 - Intimidated to show up; feel like I don't know enough, don't know the right people to talk to, don't have the language, though I would feel more comfortable with joining others and appreciate
 - These people are meant to represent us, not the people in power; events for us are compelling and facilitate more change than just one person
 - Can't face the indignity of asking politicians to recognize my humanity
 - Overwhelmed and heartbroken and angry

- 21.8% of LGBTQ have alcohol disorder compared to 11% of general population
- New Program; good support on campus; emulate traditional collegiate experience for students in recovery (any addictive disorder)

- Wednesdays at 7 in Coates 212 for weekly meeting, might pause during summer and restart in Fall; called "Collegiate Recovery Meeting"
 - Faculty and staff are welcome to participate

- Stress = craving; being sober on a college campus is stressful without the additional stressors currently happening
