**Admissions, Standards, & Honors Committee Meeting**

**LSU Union Orleans Room**

**February 06, 2006 10:30 am - 12:00 pm**

1. Minutes from the January 23, 2006 meeting were approved as distributed. Motion, Koray; Second, Griffin; Vote, unanimous.
2. The Committee authorized the Office of Undergraduate Admissions to continue to identify students who have potential for success at LSU and who might benefit from a proven summer program prior to regular admission. The proposal dated February 6, 2006 was approved as distributed. Motion, Griffin; Second, Larock; Vote, unanimous.
3. After discussion, a proposal regarding admission to Theatre, concentration in arts administration was deferred for further analysis.
4. The Committee received an enquiry from the College of Engineering about implementation of the policy concerning F grades passed on October 3, 2005. To reinforce and clarify the intent of the Committee, the following resolution passed.  

The policy that restricts the number of times students can fail a course, which becomes effective in Fall 2006, applies to both entering and continuing students. Motion, Bengtson; Second, Koray; Vote, unanimous.
5. There was a brief discussion of the ongoing project to examine admissions processes. Karen Denby distributed a comparison of admissions standards at LSU Flagship peers, the Big Ten and five other universities.
6. The meeting adjourned at 11:10 am.
