1. Meeting was called to order at 8:05 A.M.
2. Minutes for September 17, 2008. James Ryon moved to approve the minutes. Yan Chen seconded. Motion passed.
3. The College of Agriculture requested this change to admission requirements. "Student transferring from another academic unit on the LSU Campus will be admitted to the College of Agriculture after they have earned at least a LSU 2.00 grade point average and a "C" better in MATH 1021 or higher and ENGL 1001 (ENGL 1004 for international students). Students from another institution must also meet University transfer admission requirements". Terry Buchanan moved to approve the request. James Ryon seconded. Motion was passed.
- 4 "Full Folder Review" was discussed. One concern of the Faculty Senate Executive Committee was that with "Full Folder Review" the faculty would lose control of the admission process. There is a Faculty Admissions Committee that consists of Bill Grimes, Music; Paul LeRoc, Oceanography; Karl Roider, History; and Linda Smith Griffin, Library Science. These faculty review all of the folders for students not meeting the published LSU admission standards. The ASH committee recommended that these faculty brief the Faculty Admissions Committee about their admissions activities. It seems the faculty is well involved in the process.
