

**Admissions, Standards and Honors (ASH) Committee Meeting, December 3, 2010  
Pleasant Hall Library/Conference Room**

Members present: Bill Armstrong, Lupe Lamadrid, Paul LaRock, Robert Perlis, Stacy Haynie, Muhammed Wahab, Maud Walsh. Andrea Houston sent a proxy to Bill Armstrong.

William Armstrong, chair, called the meeting to order at 4:10 pm.

The minutes of the November 19<sup>th</sup> meeting were discussed and a slight revision incorporated. Because there was not a quorum, the minutes were not approved, so the revised version will be presented at the next meeting.

**Discussion of final wording for resolution to Faculty Senate re: LSU Version of Board of Regents (BOR) Core (2012) recommendation**

The Committee reviewed a draft of the resolution to the Faculty Senate supporting the LSU Version of the BOR CORE 12 admissions requirements, and agreed to shorten the resolution and to incorporate a table showing the present LSU CORE and the proposed Core for 2012 admissions [for final version that resulted from the suggestions see document entitled FS ASH-Resolution Admission Requirements Final that was presented at the Faculty Senate meeting on December 8, 2010].

**Introduction of proposal by Office of Undergraduate Admissions & Student Aid regarding additional course options for students admitted to the Summer Provisional Program**

Haynie and Lamadrid explained the request by Office of Undergraduate Admissions and Student Aid for an adjustment to the current course requirements for successful completion of the Summer Provisional Program (SPROV), specifically the addition of science courses as an option to the current course requirements. Armstrong read an email from Houston asking whether the proposal could be broadened to include any general education class, but Haynie and Lamadrid felt that this expansion is not necessary, as the science class would most likely provide gen ed credit. The Committee will continue discussion of the proposal and vote at the next meeting.
