7-Day Accumulated Rainfall & Average Temperatures: 01 - 07 Apr 2026

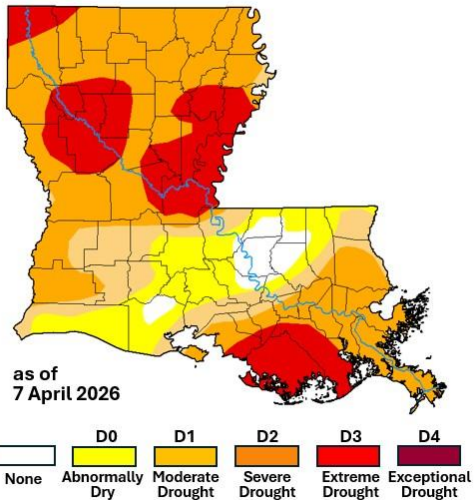


- after a mostly-dry period dating back to mid-March, showers and thunderstorms embedded within southerly flow off the Gulf, followed by a frontal passage on Apr 04-05, delivered beneficial rains to much of the state
- in spite of the welcomed rains, weekly totals were below-normal for a broad swath of parishes extending from the coast to the LA/AR border

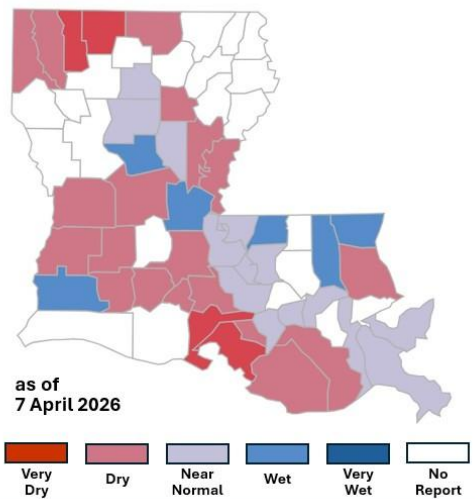


- the 7-day period began with much warmer-than-normal temperatures due to persistent southerly flow off the Gulf, even during the nighttime hours
- a frontal passage on Apr 04-05 brought a significant cooldown that resulted in lows in the upper 30's and lower 40's the morning of Apr 07
- despite the frontal passage, average temperatures during the period as a whole were above 7-day normals

U.S. Weekly Drought Monitor



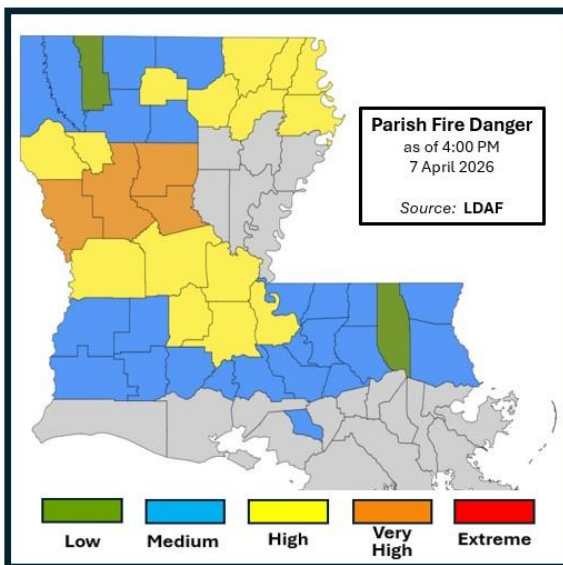
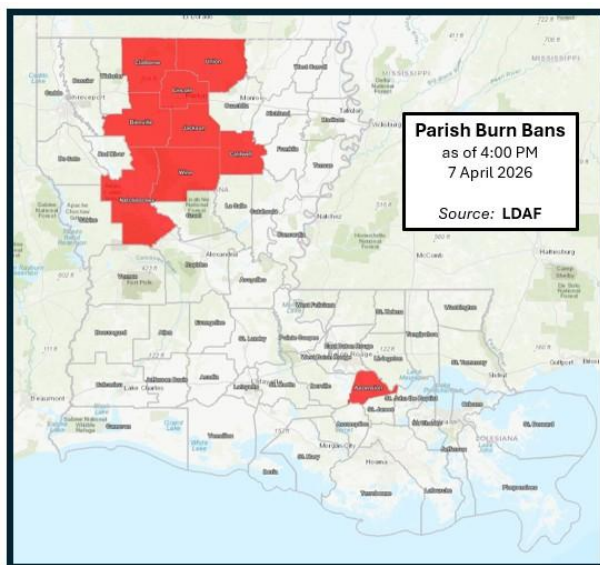
LSU AgCenter Field Conditions



U.S. Drought Monitor (USDM): Issued April 09, 2026

- includes data thru April 07

- after mostly-dry conditions since mid-March across the Bayou State, a more active pattern during the 7-day monitoring period brought scattered showers and occasional t'storms embedded in "moist" southerly flow off the Gulf followed by a frontal passage on Apr 04-05 that produced more widespread precipitation
- 7-day rain totals were heaviest across northwestern and especially southeastern Louisiana, where isolated locations including Bogalusa, Tickfaw, Independence, and St. Francisville reported flash flooding
- in response to improvements in soil moisture, streamflows, and vegetation in southeastern Louisiana, the updated **Drought Monitor** showed minor improvements; however, the rest of the state outside of a portion of Calcasieu Parish did not improve due to minimal hydrologic responses
- the **USDM** shows over 80% of the state in some level of drought: almost half of the state was classified under 'Severe Drought' (D2) with nearly 1/4th of Louisiana posted as in 'Extreme Drought' (D3)
- of the reports received as of Apr 07, LSU AgCenter agents noted "Very Dry" or "Dry" conditions for 22 parishes but also noted that conditions had "Significantly" or "Slightly" improved in 23 parishes
- as of Apr 07, Parish Fire Danger Levels were posted as "Very High" for 4 parishes and "High" for 10 parishes
- as of Apr 07, the same 9 parishes were under Burn Bans as during the prior monitoring period

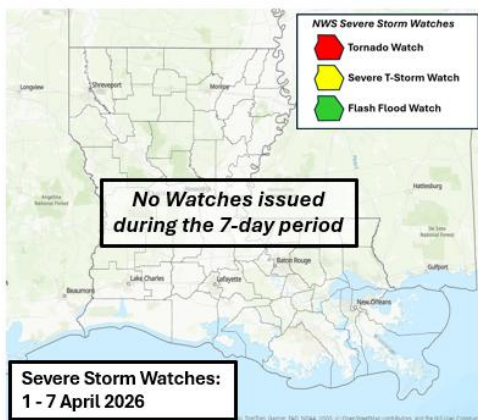
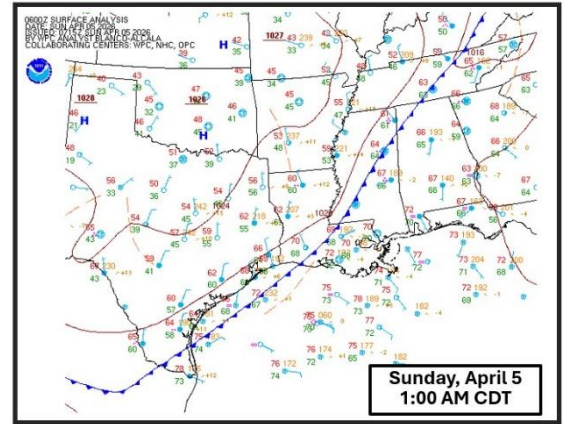


Parish **Burn Bans** are issued and lifted by local designated agencies and/or officials. **Daily Fire Danger** maps are produced by the USDA Forest Service, the Nat'l Interagency Fire Center (NIFC) & the LDAF.

Severe Weather:

The NWS Storm Prediction Center did not issue any *Watches* for Louisiana over the 7-day stretch but forecast offices in Jackson (JAN) and Slidell (LIX) did post a handful of local *Warnings*. JAN's two *Severe T-Storm Warnings* were both issued on the afternoon of Apr 4. *Severe T-Storm Warnings* were issued by LIX on Apr 1, 2, and 4 with *Flash Flood Warnings* posted by LIX on Apr 1, 3, and 4. LIX also issued a pair of *Tornado Warnings* on the afternoon of Apr 4 based on radar-indicated circulations, but no touchdowns were confirmed (as of this report).

Only a handful of *Local Storm Reports* were posted by the state's NWS offices. These included quarter-sized hail in and around Bogalusa on the evening of Apr 1, thunderstorm winds in Tangipahoa Parish along with localized flooding in Tangipahoa and Livingston parishes on the late afternoon and evening of Apr 2, and another bout of localized flooding due to heavy downpours near St. Francisville on the evening of Apr 4.

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Precipitation and temperature data are primarily retrieved through the ACIS QueryBuilder (rcc-acis.org) and the cli-MATE platform (MRCC Application Tools Environment), both of which are maintained by the NOAA Regional Climate Centers (RCCs).
