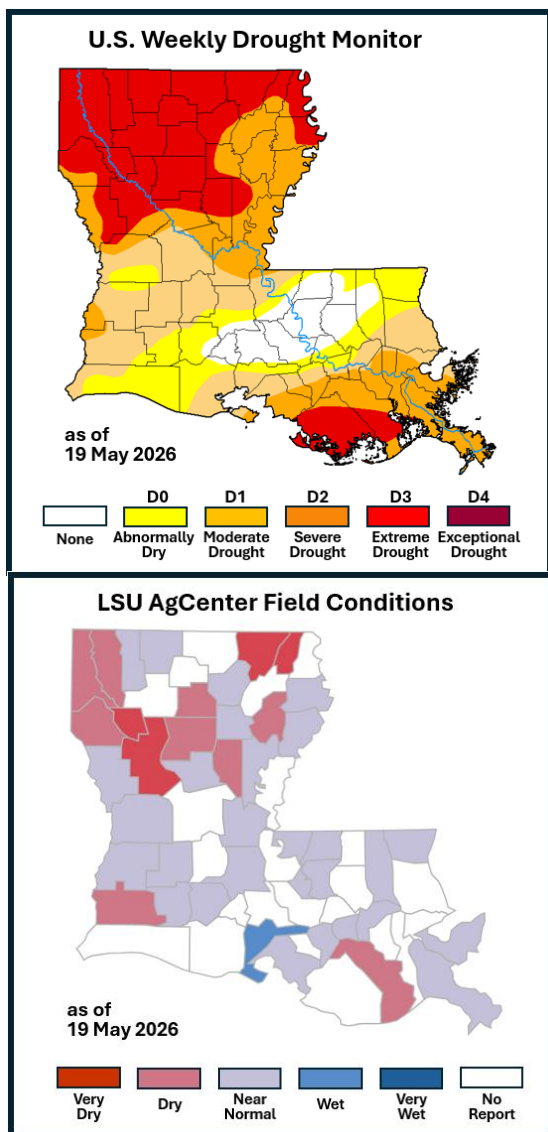
7-Day Accumulated Rainfall & Average Temperatures: 13 - 19 May 2026



- the 7-day period started dry as a front that entered the state on May 14 provided no precipitation; however, persistent southerly flow off the Gulf contributed to rainfall for much of the state by the end of the period
- rain totals were below 7-day normals for almost all of the Bayou State which was welcome after several days of heavy rainfall for numerous parishes (as a majority of reporting sites provide 24-hour totals at 7-8 AM local time, much of the rain that fell on May 19 is recorded on the 20th and not included in this review)



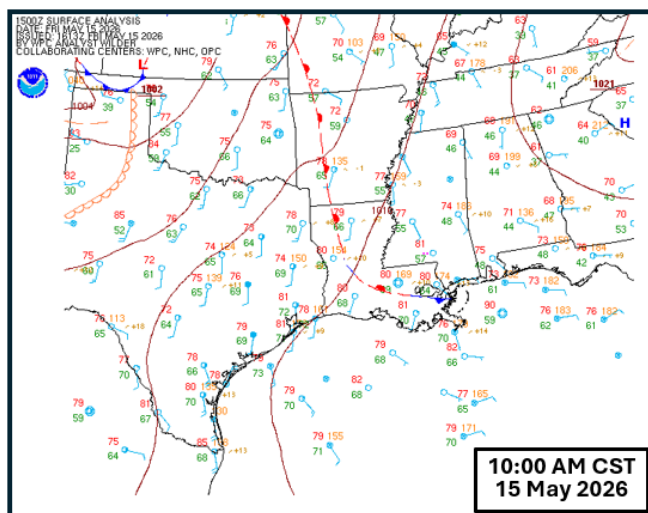
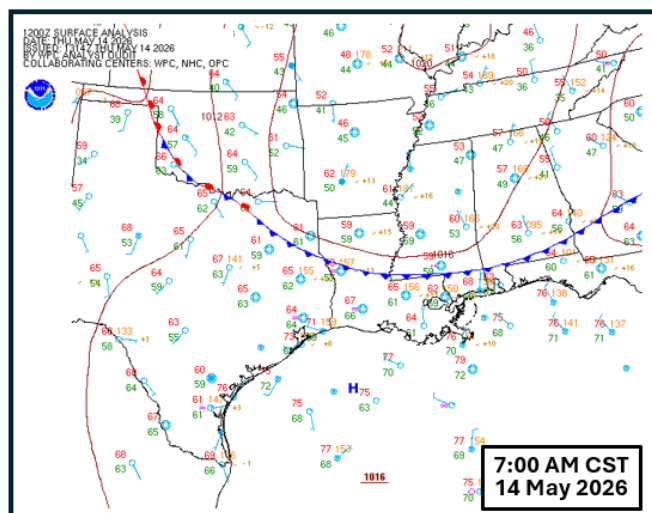
- for the first time in three 7-day periods, average temperatures were above-normal as precipitation was more limited and the state was under persistent “warm” southerly flow off the Gulf
- drier air present during the initial portion of the period and the subsequent warm-up resulted in a wide range of temperatures, including a statewide low of 50°F at Homer 1 N & Monroe 26 N (NC div) on the morning of May 13 and a statewide high of 93°F at Baton Rouge Metro AP (EC div) on May 18



U.S. Drought Monitor (USDM): Issued May 21, 2026

- includes data thru May 19

- the Bayou State welcomed a mostly-dry 7-day monitoring period after several days of at times flooding rains; temperatures were slightly above-normal but increases in moisture demand (ETo) were met by moisture reserves across central and southern Louisiana; however, that was not the case across northern Louisiana
- in response, the updated **Drought Monitor** showed an increase in aerial coverage of 'Extreme Drought' (D3) across northern Louisiana while noting improvements across southern Louisiana where hydrological conditions continued to respond positively from prior rainfall
- with the mix of improvements and degradations, the amount of drought coverage depicted by the **USDM** remained relatively steady, with more than 75% of the state posted as "in drought"
- the 7-day drought summary through May 19th shows a slight increase in D3 to just under 1/3rd of the state, 'Severe Drought' (D2) coverage remained at just over 1/2 of the state, and 'Moderate Drought' (D1) spanning nearly 1/4th of Louisiana
- of the reports received as of May 19, LSU AgCenter agents noted "Very Dry" or "Dry" conditions across 13 parishes (mostly across northern LA) with "Near Normal" conditions noted for 28 parishes; agents also noted "No Substantial Change" or "Slightly Improved" conditions for 37 parishes
- as of May 19, no parishes had Burn Bans in effect and parish Fire Danger Levels (not shown) were listed as "High" for 11 parishes, all across northern Louisiana



The southward advance and subsequent dissipation of the "dry" front of May 14-15 as mentioned on p. 2.

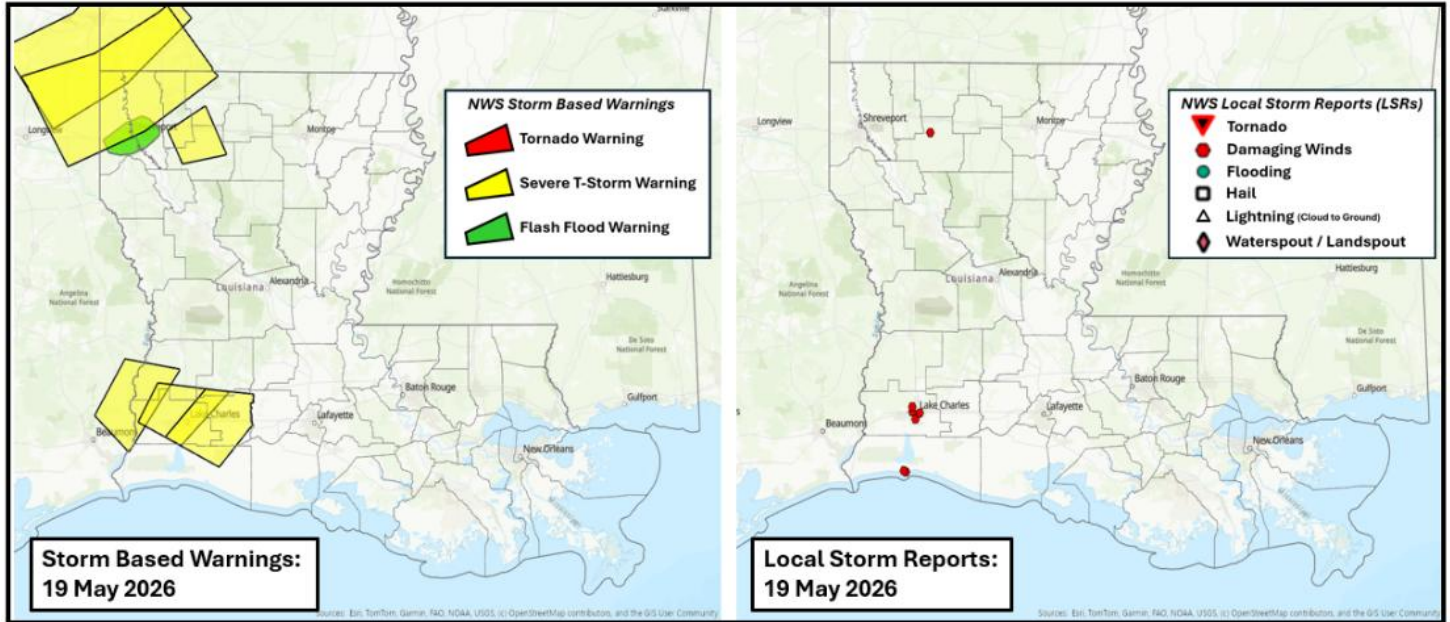
Severe Weather:

Overall, it was a relatively quiet 7-day stretch in terms of active/severe storms. The only significant activity was limited to the afternoon and evening of May 19.

No *Watches* were posted for Louisiana on that date. The Shreveport and Lake Charles NWS offices accounted for six *Severe Thunderstorm Warnings*

plus a single *Flash Flood Warning* (NW Louisiana) on the 19th.

Local Storm Reports on the 19th were limited to damaging winds associated with the severe t-storms in the north-western and southwestern portions of the state.

Drought data are sourced from the U.S. Drought Monitor (unl.edu), the LSU AgCenter, and the Louisiana Dept. of Agriculture & Forestry.
