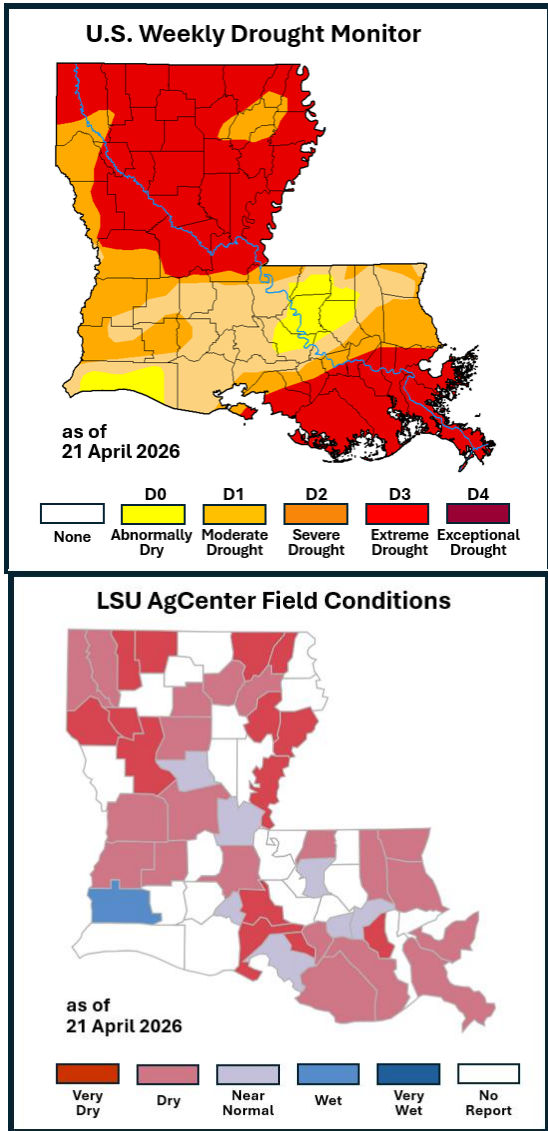
7-Day Accumulated Rainfall & Average Temperatures: 15 - 21 Apr 2026



- a frontal passage on Apr 18 (p. 4) provided most of Louisiana's rainfall over the 7-day period, but a majority of the state recorded less than 0.50" for the period
- rainfall shortages were the greatest across the northern third of the state for the 7-day run; yet another drier-than-normal stretch of days meant additional moisture stress across most of the state, adding to the intensification of drought virtually statewide (p. 3).



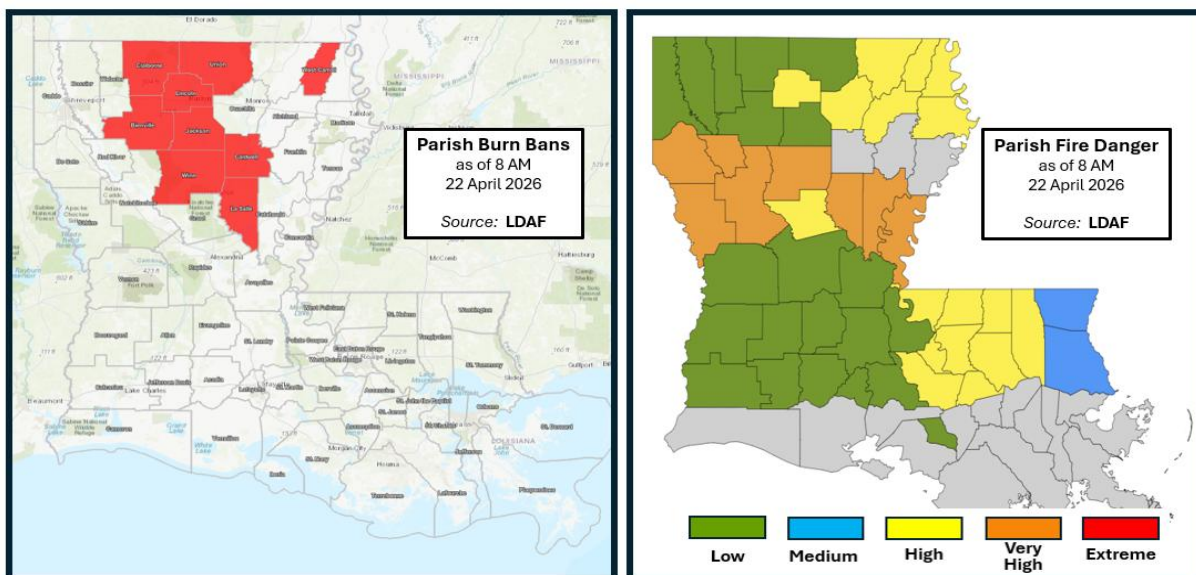
- the 7-day period started off with above-normal (and in some cases record or near-record) temperatures as the Bayou State was under southerly flow off the Gulf ahead of the Apr 18 frontal passage
- following the cold front passage, temperatures were cooler-than-normal for many locations
- the two distinct air masses (on either side of the Apr 18 front) delivered a wide range of temperatures: the state's maximum temp was a summer-like 90°F at Monroe MLU AP (Apr 17) while the statewide minimum was a "winter-ish" 38°F at Monroe 26 N (Apr 20)
- overall, average temperatures were much closer to 7-day normals than recent weeks, although still above normal for the majority of the state



U.S. Drought Monitor (USDM): Issued April 23, 2026

- includes data thru April 21

- it was another drier-than-normal 7-day monitoring period for the majority of the state; a cold front on Apr 18 provided only limited rain amounts with no other significant precipitation events
- warmer-than-normal conditions prior to the frontal passage combined with sunshine, lower humidities, and breezy conditions after the passage to increase soil-water deficits around the state
- in response, the updated **Drought Monitor** as of Apr 21 shows a significant expansion of drought, with roughly 94% of Louisiana classified as “in drought”
- ‘Extreme Drought’ (D3) now extends over more than half of Louisiana, including almost all of northern Louisiana; “Severe Drought” (D2) extends across more than 20% of the state
- of the reports received as of Apr 21, LSU AgCenter agents noted “Very Dry” or “Dry” conditions across 33 parishes and stated that conditions had at least “Slightly Degraded” in 14 parishes
- as of Apr 22, 9 parishes across northern and central Louisiana still have parish-instituted Burn Bans and Parish Fire Danger Levels were posted as “Very High” or “High” for 25 parishes
- on Apr 17, the USDA designated 25 parishes as “natural disaster areas” due to the ongoing drought, which allows for emergency loan assistance through the Farm Service Agency . . . in addition to the 25 designated parishes, 23 “contiguous” parishes are also eligible for assistance



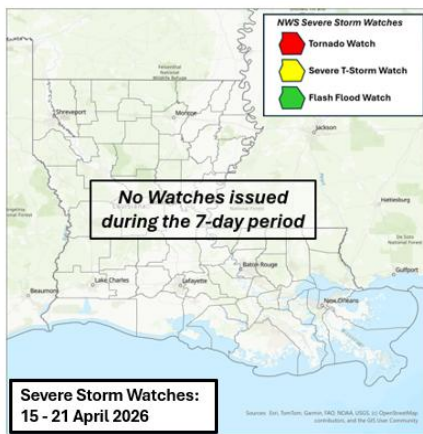
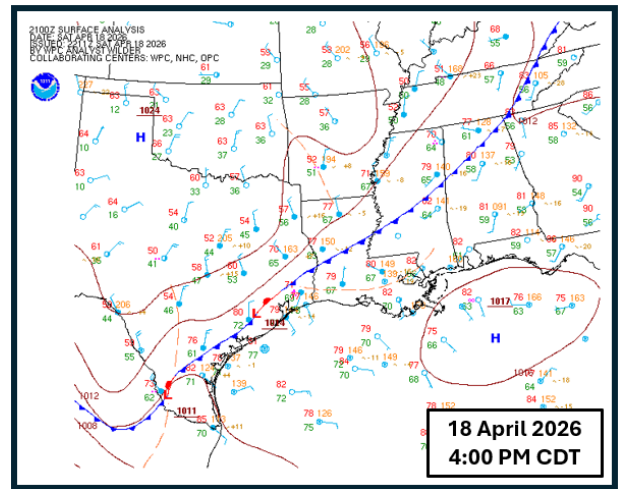
Parish **Burn Bans** are issued and lifted by local designated agencies and/or officials. **Daily Fire Danger** maps are produced by the USDA Forest Service, the Nat'l Interagency Fire Center (NIFC) & the LDAF.

Severe Weather:

Severe weather was not an issue for the 7-day period. The NWS Storm Prediction Center did not issue any *Watches* for Louisiana over the 7-day stretch and there were no local *Storm Based Warnings* issued by any of the four NWS forecast offices serving Louisiana.

A cold front did work its way across Louisiana on April 18th, generating a few rumbles of thunder but no severe thunderstorms. Indeed, the front was a disappointment for many as it produced only limited amounts of rain around the state.

There were no occurrences of *Dense Fog Advisories* nor any *Red Flag Warnings* issued during the 7-day stretch.

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Precipitation and temperature data are primarily retrieved through the ACIS QueryBuilder (rcc-acis.org) and the cli-MATE platform (MRCC Application Tools Environment), both of which are maintained by the NOAA Regional Climate Centers (RCCs).
