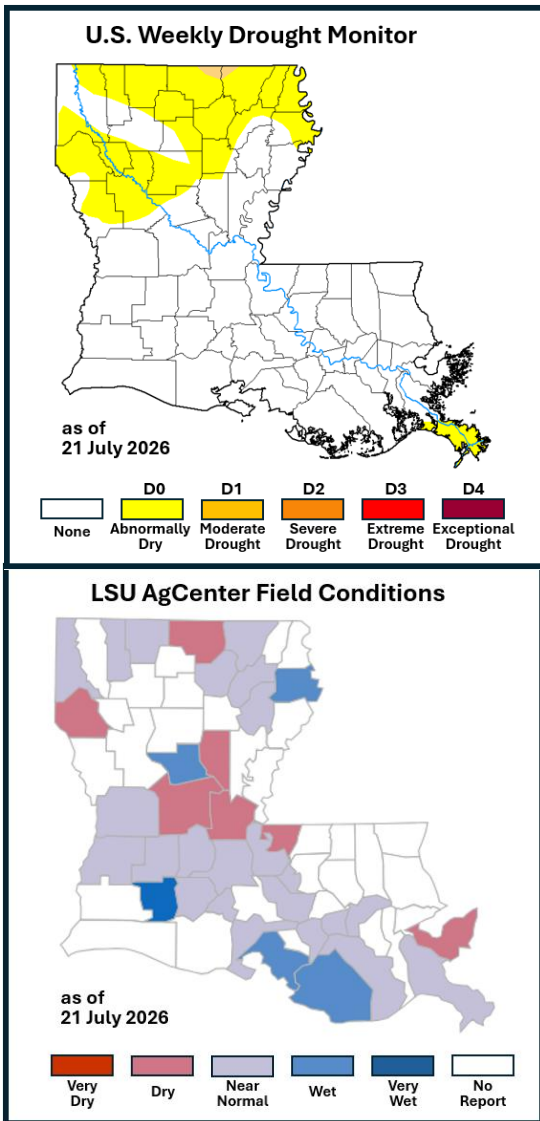
7-Day Accumulated Rainfall & Average Temperatures: 15 - 21 July 2026



- the 7-day run started out mostly quiet as the Bayou State was under the influence of high pressure; however, isolated downpours of 3.00" to 6.00" took place in the Lake Charles area (SW Div) on July 14th (included in the 24-hr totals on the 15th), although the Lake Charles Airport (LCH AP) remained completely dry
- Tropical Storm Bertha formed south of the Florida panhandle on July 20 and precipitation indirectly related to it began to fall over southeastern Louisiana on July 20 and increased on July 21 (a Bertha discussion will be included in the next 7-day summary, July 22-28)
- most of the state received less than 0.25" during the period and many stations recorded no rainfall for the period (pp. 5-8)



- average temperatures were above 7-day norms across almost all of Louisiana as the state was under the influence of high pressure, allowing maximum daytime heating
- per LOSC analysis, stations cracked the 100°F barrier for the first time this summer: 101°F at Monroe MLU AP (NE Div) on July 21 and 100°F on July 20, and 100°F at Natchitoches #2 (WC Div) on July 21



U.S. Drought Monitor (USDM): Issued July 23, 2026

- includes data thru July 21

- it was a mostly-dry 7-day period as the Bayou State was under the influence of surface high pressure most of the time; however, 7-day rain totals of 3.00" or more were reported in the Lake Charles area, with most of that rain falling in just a few hours on the 14th (reported on the 15th for morning-reporting sites);
- while dry for most of the state, moisture reserves from over two months of wet conditions were more than enough to meet the increased moisture demand
- vegetation health, soil moisture conditions, and river/creek/bayou levels all remained good despite the run of dry and hot days
- for the first time since late-December 2025, the new **Drought Monitor** depiction showed no changes in Louisiana from the previous week
- of the reports received as of July 21, LSU AgCenter agents noted 'Dry' conditions in 7 parishes, 5 parish were tagged as 'Wet' or 'Very Wet', all other parish reports indicated 'Near Normal' conditions
- as of July 20, the USDA noted 'Adequate' or 'Surplus' topsoil and subsoil conditions for 75% and 70% of the state, respectively; pasture and range conditions were noted as 'Fair', 'Good', or 'Excellent' for all but 6% of Louisiana
- as of July 22, no parishes had Burn Bans and parish Fire Danger Levels were listed as 'High' for 10 parishes across northeastern Louisiana and 'Medium' or 'Low' for all other monitored parishes (maps not included)

Extreme Heat Warnings: 21 July 2026

As the calendar rolls into the 'heart' of Louisiana's summertime heat and humidity, residents need to take extra precautions to avoid heat exhaustion, heat stroke or worse.

As of this writing, there have been at least 4 heat-related fatalities (*preliminary data*) in Louisiana during 2026.

NWS *Heat Advisories* have become almost commonplace across Louisiana this summer, as temperatures (and dew points) have trended above-normal for much of the past two months.

Indeed, the degree of discomfort reached levels that prompted the NWS/Jackson (MS) and NWS/Shreveport offices to issue *Extreme Heat Warnings* for northeastern and parts of north-central Louisiana on July 21st. By the late afternoon, several 'official' and 'unofficial' sites in the warned area were displaying heat index values in the 115° to 120° range!



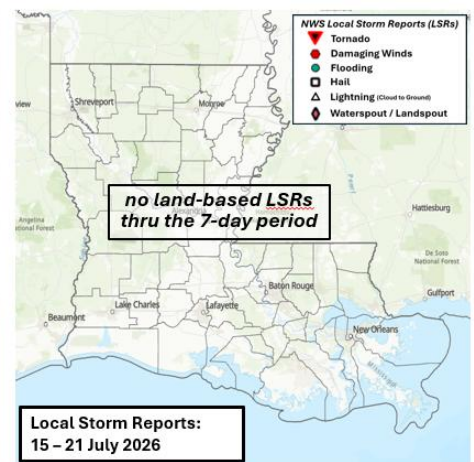
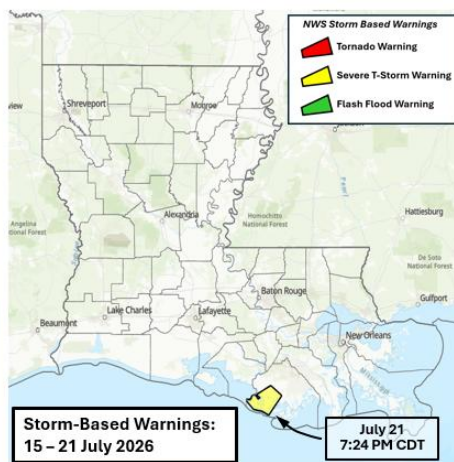
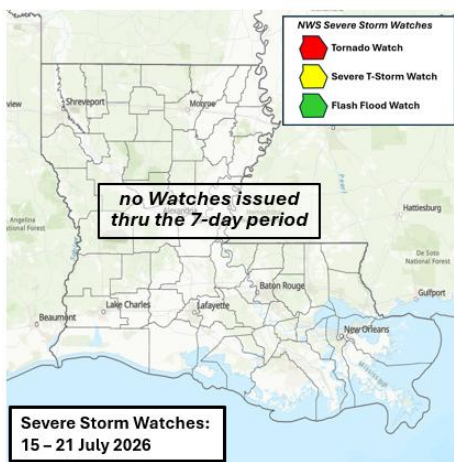
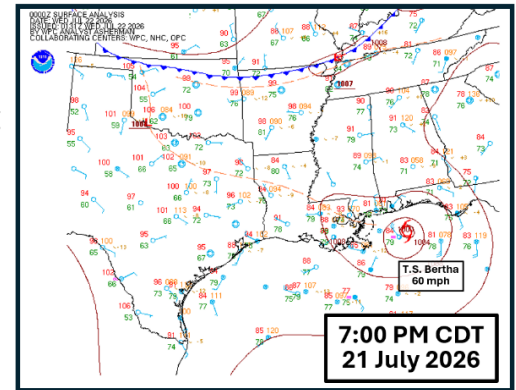
Severe/Stormy Weather:

The good news through the 7-day period was a lack of active/severe weather anywhere within the Pelican State, although that comes as little surprise given the general lack of rainfall across the state during the stretch. A single *Severe T-Storm Warning* was issued on the evening of July 21 for an unpopulated area of marshland in southwestern Terrebonne Parish and adjacent Point Au Fer Island.

While the weather was generally quiet (albeit very hot) across Louisiana for most of the 7 days, attention was turning to the northeastern Gulf.

The National Hurricane Center had been highlighting a broad area extending across the Florida Peninsula for days, with the highlighted zone migrating westward into the Gulf with time. The low-pressure area was tagged as *Invest 91L* on the afternoon of July 18 and earned the upgrade to *Tropical Depression #2* on Sunday afternoon.

In spite of strong wind shear, *T.D. #2* was upgraded to *Tropical Storm Bertha* on the evening of July 20 as it tracked from east-to-west across the northeastern Gulf.
