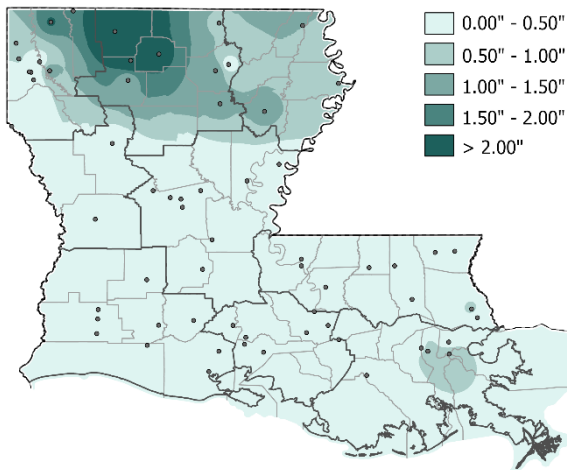

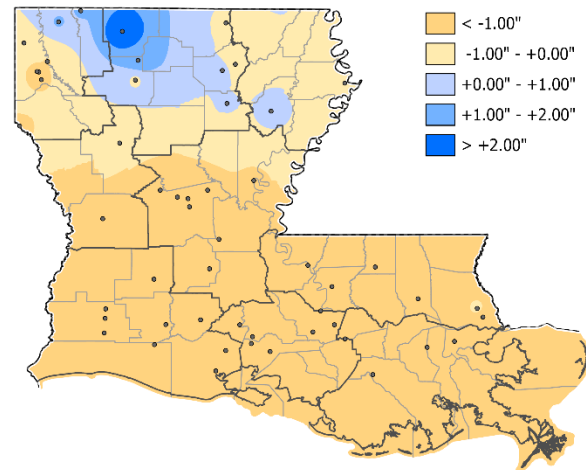
7-Day Accumulated Rainfall & Average Temperatures: 24 - 30 June 2026

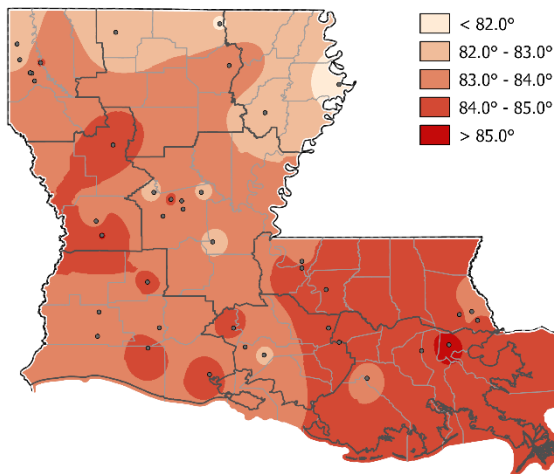
7-Day Departure from Normal Precipitation (Inches)

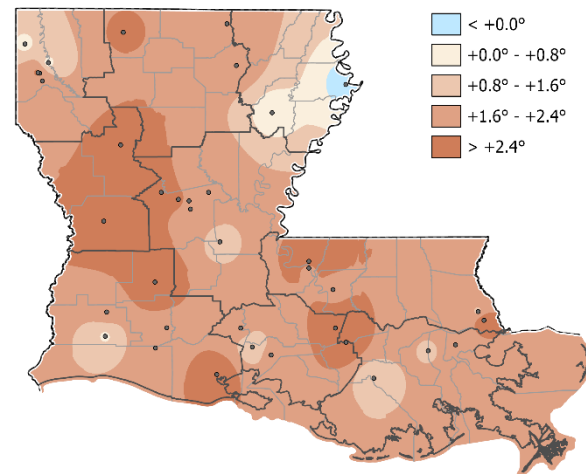
- after several weeks of generally wetter-than-normal conditions, most of the Pelican State enjoyed a drier 7-day run as high pressure became the dominant weather feature
- the only significant precipitation during the period was across northern Louisiana as thunderstorm complexes moved in from Arkansas around the eastern edge of high pressure, prompting NWS/Shreveport to issue a *Flash Flood Warning* on June 24th (p. 4)

Mean Average Temperature (°F)



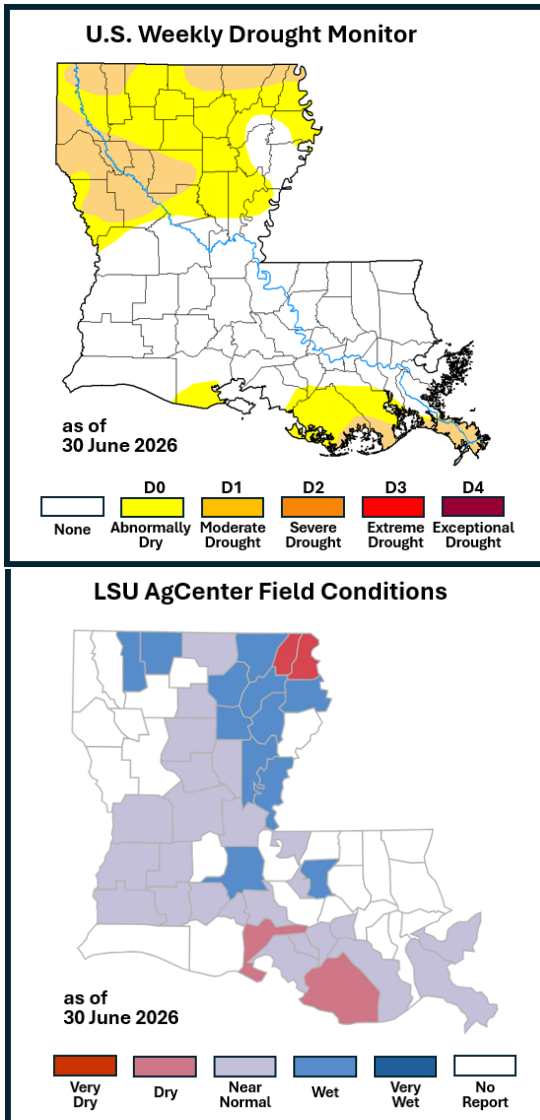

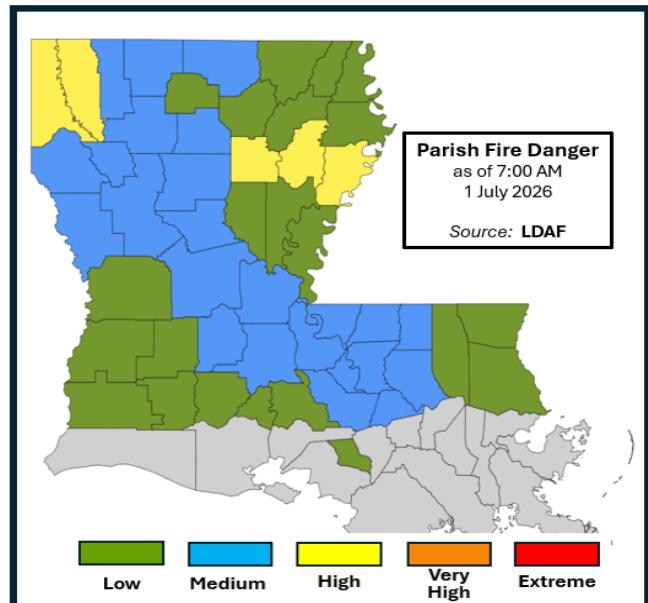
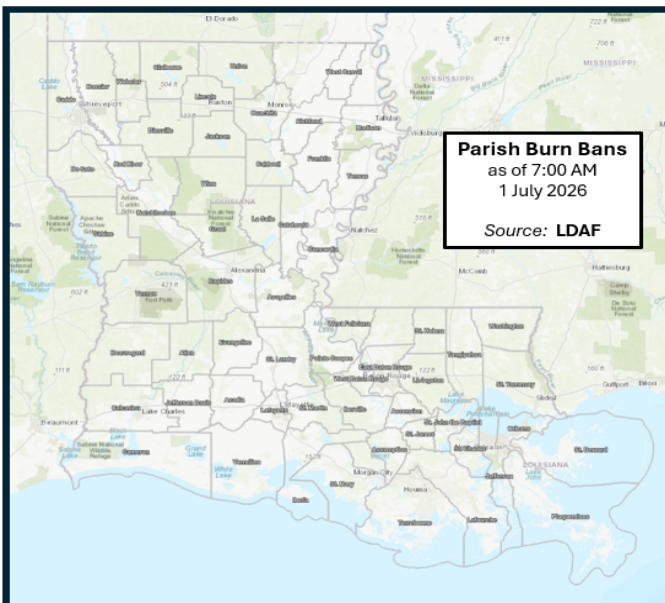
- average temperatures were above 7-day norms for almost the entire state, mostly driven by divisional daily high temperatures averaging in the low to mid 90's (p. 4)
- high pressure reduced rain/cloud cover while southerly flow off the Gulf kept humidities high, allowing for heat index values to soar well above 100°F, reaching a peak of 107°F at Monroe MLU AP on 06/29 and Lafayette LFT AP on 06/28, 106°F at Tallulah TVR AP and Alexandria ESF AP on 06/28 as well as Baton Rouge Metro AP and Slidell ASD AP on 06/30 and NO-Lakefront AP on 06/24, and 105°F at Shreveport SHV AP on 06/28



U.S. Drought Monitor (USDM): Issued July 02, 2026

- includes data thru June 30

- after several wetter-than-normal weeks, the Bayou State experienced drier conditions as high pressure dominated the weather pattern, allowing saturated soils to dry out and flooded rivers/bayous/creeks to recede below flood stage
- the only significant precipitation was across northern Louisiana during the initial portion of this 7-day period which allowed for continued moisture recovery of soils, vegetation, stock ponds, etc.
- elsewhere across the state, elevated evapotranspiration (ETo) due to high temperatures was offset by adequate or surplus soil moisture which met demand despite drier-than-normal weather
- in response, the updated **Drought Monitor** showed improvements across northern Louisiana, eliminating 'Severe' drought (D2); in fact, the new **USDM** depiction for Louisiana shows no 'Severe or Extreme' drought (D2 or D3) anywhere in the state for the first time since Christmas 2025
- of the reports received as of June 30, only 4 LSU AgCenter parish agents noted 'Very Dry' or 'Dry' conditions while all others noted 'Near Normal' or 'Very Wet' conditions; improvements were noted by 14 agents while 6 noted that conditions had degraded modestly
- as of June 29, the USDA noted 'Adequate' or 'Surplus' topsoil and subsoil moisture conditions for 81% and 71% of the state, respectively; pasture and range conditions were noted as 'Fair', 'Good', or 'Excellent' for all but 10% of Louisiana
- as of July 1, no parishes had Burn Bans in effect; Fire Danger Levels were listed as 'High' for 5 parishes and 'Medium' or 'Low' for the remainder of the state



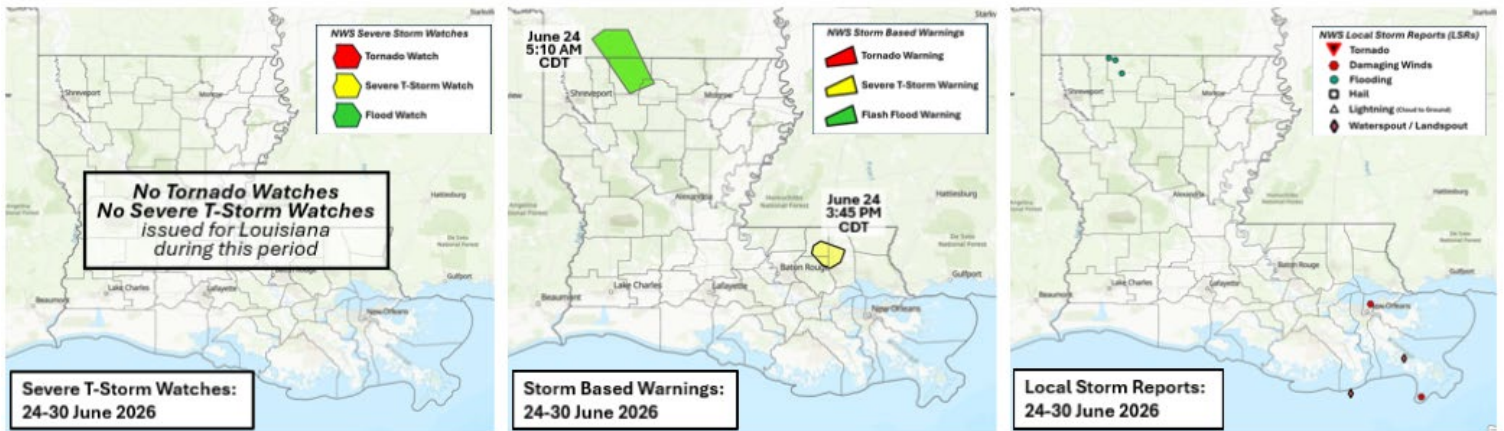
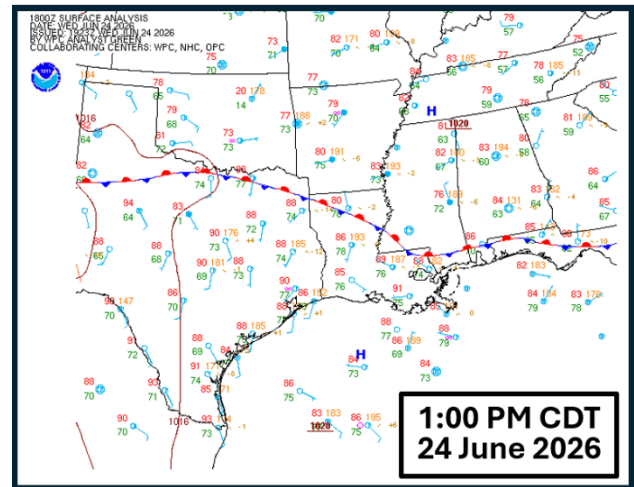
Parish **Burn Bans** are issued and lifted by local designated agencies and/or officials. **Daily Fire Danger** maps are produced by the USDA Forest Service, the Nat'l Interagency Fire Center (NIFC) & the LDAF.

Severe/Stormy Weather:

A weak 'backdoor cool front' slipped into northern Louisiana on June 24, then stalled and meandered across northern and central parishes before dissipating the following day. That front spawned the only two *Warnings* for the period: a *Flash Flood Warning* impacting several northwestern parishes on the morning of the 24th and a single *Severe T-Storm Warning* over the central Florida Parishes on the afternoon of the 24th.

Otherwise, the 7-day run was fairly quiet, with no *Watches* and little rainfall for most of the remainder of the state.

(Note: the LOSC does not include waterspouts in the tornado logs unless those 'spouts' move onto land.)

Precipitation and temperature data are primarily retrieved through the ACIS QueryBuilder (rcc-acis.org) and the cli-MATE platform (MRCC Application Tools Environment), both of which are maintained by the NOAA Regional Climate Centers (RCCs).

Drought data are sourced from the U.S. Drought Monitor (unl.edu), the LSU AgCenter, and the Louisiana Dept. of Agriculture & Forestry.
