7-Day Accumulated Rainfall & Average Temperatures: 27 May - 02 June 2026

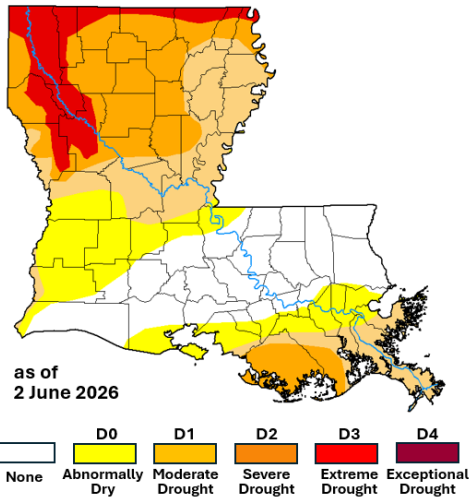


- another active 7-day run across the Bayou State with several rounds of precipitation that led to localized flooding and prompted the NWS to issue a handful of *Flash Flood Warnings* and *Flood Advisories* in addition to *Severe Thunderstorm Warnings* (p. 4)
- a surface trough and low-pressure enhanced precipitation initially . . . the pattern then became more summer-like with showers and t-storms developing during the heat of the day and in association with afternoon sea-breezes and occasional outflow boundary interactions
- A 'cool' front began a slow north-to-south advance through the state on June 02

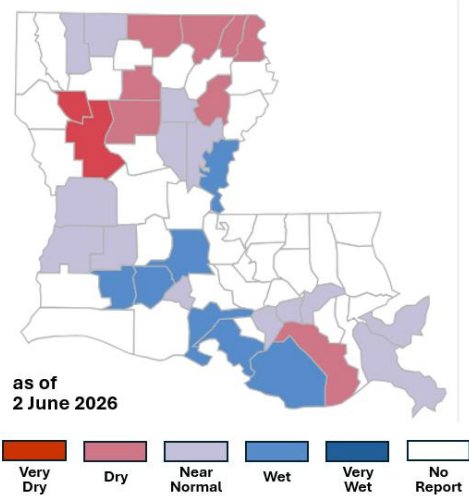


- "meteorological summer" began June 01 with the warmest 7-day period of the year season thus far; average daily high temperatures were near 90°F for most divisions with average low temperatures running above 70°F across all divisions (p. 5)
- several stations reached the mid-90's, with three north Louisiana sites -- Red River Research Station (NW Div), Monroe MLU AP (NC Div), and Natchitoches #2 (WC Div) -- all reporting a 7-day high temperature of 96°F during the period

U.S. Weekly Drought Monitor



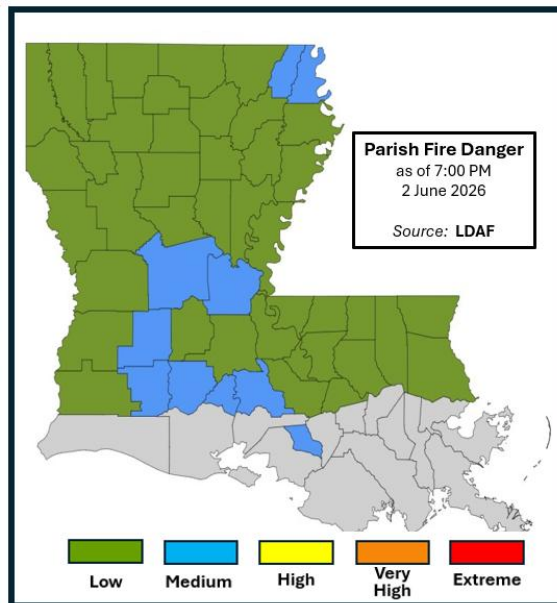
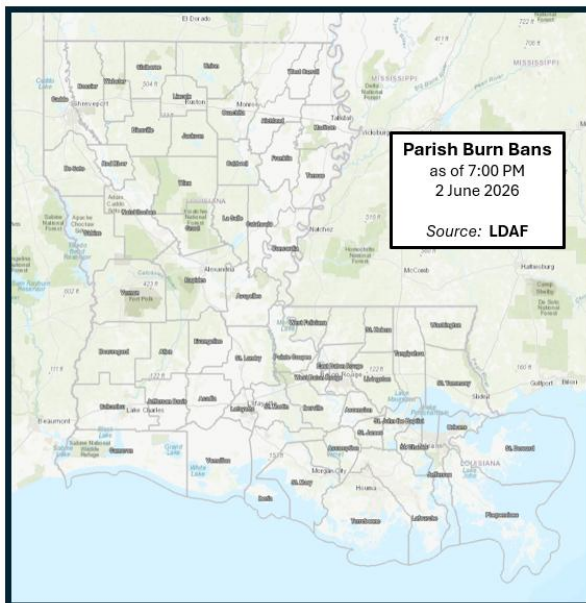
LSU AgCenter Field Conditions



U.S. Drought Monitor (USDM): Issued June 04, 2026

- includes data thru June 02

- the recent run of wet 7-day periods continued with multiple rounds of rain and thunderstorms moving through the Bayou state which continued to replenish (and at times saturate) soils and meet moisture demand (ET_o) despite the hottest temperatures of the season so far
- in response, the updated **Drought Monitor** showed improvements across the entire state, including a significant reduction in D3 ('Extreme') drought coverage across northern Louisiana with reductions in D2 ('Severe'), and D1 ('Moderate') coverage across all portions of the state
- after the improvements, the **USDM** shows D3 coverage at just under 10% which is the lowest since late-February and total drought coverage (D1-D3) at just under 55%, the lowest since late-January; over 1/4th of the state is neither in drought or abnormally dry, the most since mid-November 2025
- of the reports received as of June 02, LSU AgCenter agents noted "Very Dry" or "Dry" conditions across 10 parishes, mostly in northern Louisiana, with "Wet" or "Near Normal" conditions noted for another 21 parishes; agents also noted "Significantly Improved" or "Slightly Improved" conditions in 11 parishes
- as of June 02, no parishes had Burn Bans and parish Fire Danger Levels were listed as "Medium" or "Low" for all monitored parishes



Parish **Burn Bans** are issued and lifted by local designated agencies and/or officials. **Daily Fire Danger** maps are produced by the USDA Forest Service, the Nat'l Interagency Fire Center (NIFC) & the LDAF.

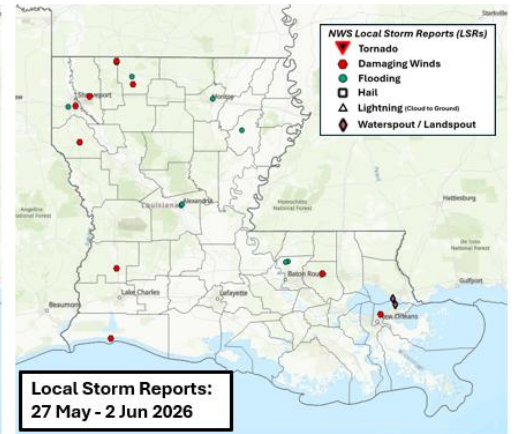
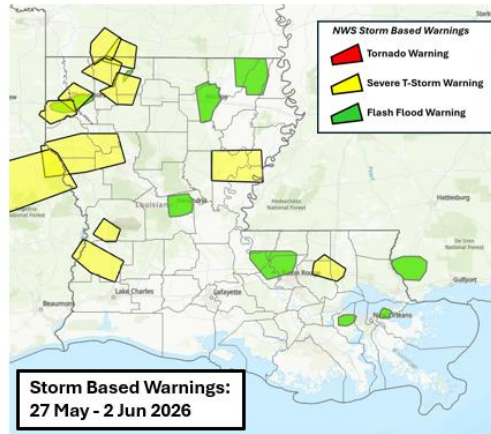
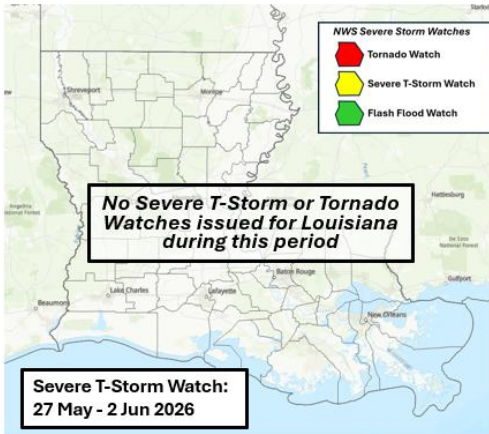
Severe/Stormy Weather:

No *Tornado* or *Severe T-Storm Watches* were issued for Louisiana through the 7-day stretch. However, concerns for locally-heavy rains and the potential for river and bayou flooding prompted the NWS to issue a *Flood Watch* across the southeastern parishes on May 27th. Fortunately, most of the significant area Waterways remained below flood stage, with the exception of the Lower Pearl.

No tornadoes were cataloged (as of this writing) nor *Tornado Warnings* issued over the 7 days, although *Local Storm Reports (LSRs)* included reports of a waterspout over eastern Lake Pontchartrain on the morning of May 28.

Storm Based Warnings (SBWs) included 9 scattered *Flash Flood Warnings* spread over 4 dates. Fortunately, no stations in the LOSC analyses recorded excessively large 24-hour rains during the period: Alexandria (C Div) recorded the state's largest single-day rain total of 3.20" on May 29 (7 AM observation).

Lastly, add a dozen *Severe T-Storm Warnings*, generating a few damaging wind reports, mostly over western Louisiana.

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Precipitation and temperature data are primarily retrieved through the ACIS QueryBuilder (rcc-acis.org) and the cli-MATE platform (MRCC Application Tools Environment), both of which are maintained by the NOAA Regional Climate Centers (RCCs).

Drought data are sourced from the U.S. Drought Monitor (unl.edu), the LSU AgCenter, and the Louisiana Dept. of Agriculture & Forestry.
