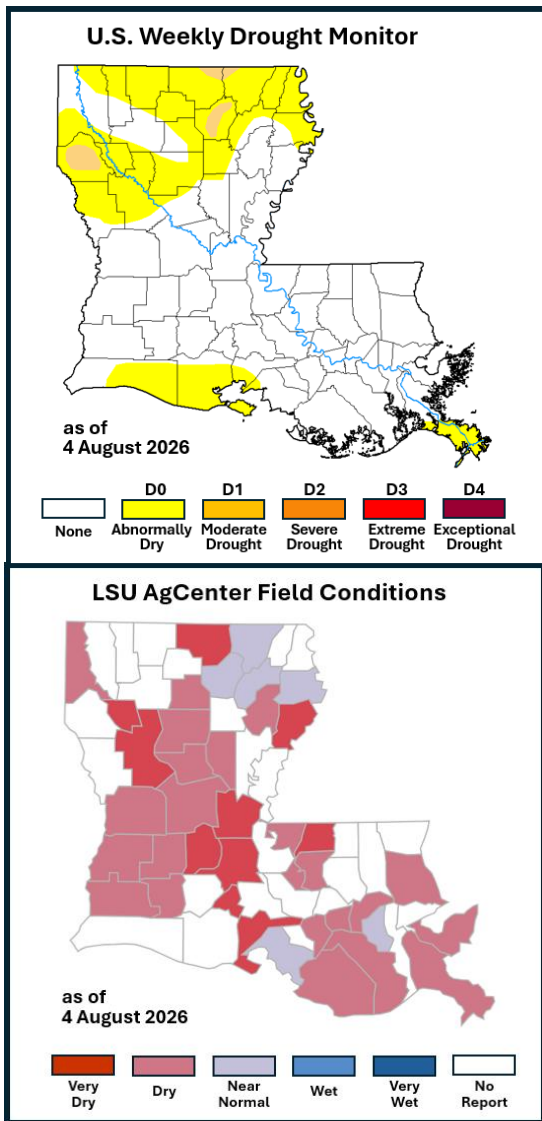
7-Day Accumulated Rainfall & Average Temperatures: 29 July - 4 Aug 2026



- precipitation coverage was limited during the 7-day stretch except across northeastern and southeastern Louisiana in association with a rare August frontal passage that occurred on August 1-2
- 7-day totals were below-normal for all except a very few locations
- this marked the third straight run of below-normal precipitation across the Bayou State and led to degradations appearing in the **U.S. Drought Monitor** for the first time in several weeks (p. 3)



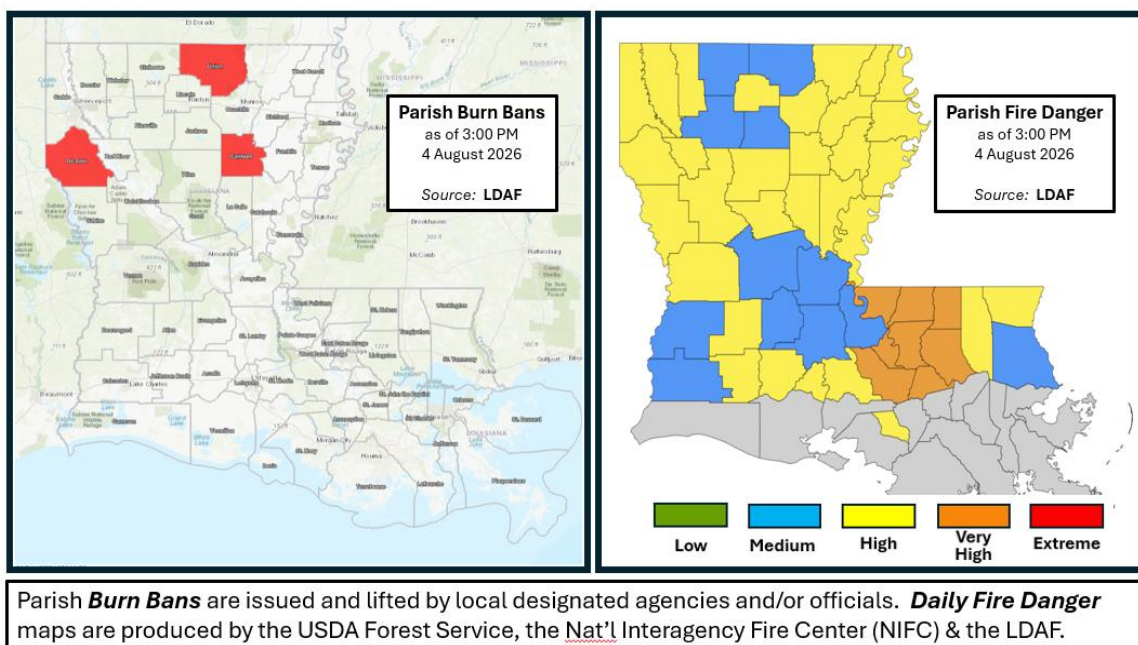
- despite a slight and brief reduction in daily maximum and minimum temperatures following the frontal passage on August 1-2, average temperatures were above 7-day normals for almost the entire state
- several stations across northern Louisiana broke the 100°F barrier during the first few days of the period (pp. 5-6); however, the aforementioned frontal passage brought drier air into the state allowing minimum temperatures in the 60's to extend as far south as central Louisiana during the mornings of August 2, 3 & 4

- includes data thru August 4

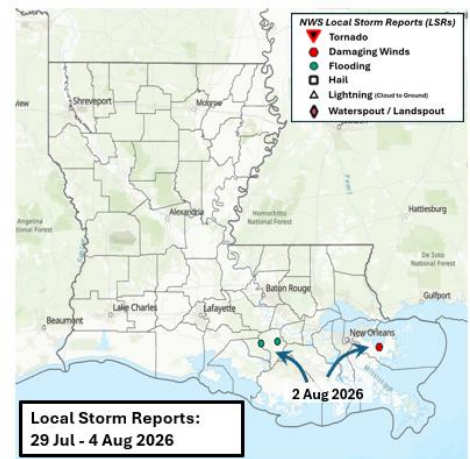
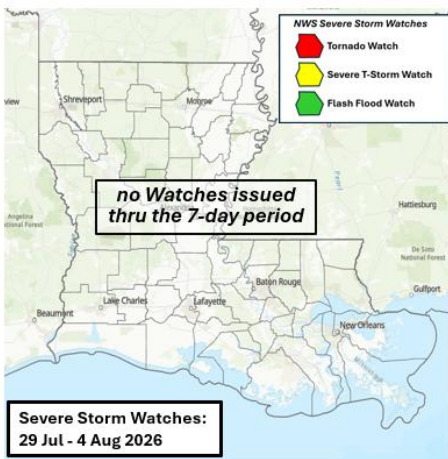
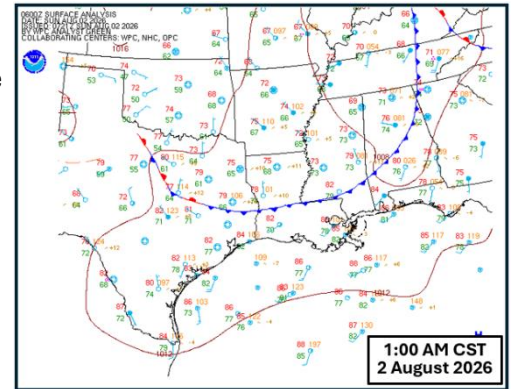
- it was another dry 7-day monitoring period across the Bayou State continuing a recent string of dry periods; a frontal passage on August 1-2 did more harm than good by providing only localized areas of precipitation while reducing humidities and inducing breezy conditions thereafter, exacerbating the drying-out process
- soil moisture reserves are trending downward and vegetation is beginning to show signs of stress; in the overall, moisture reserves are still in the normal range for most of the state but are on the verge of being depleted and already have been in some areas
- for the first time in several weeks, the new **U.S. Drought Monitor** depiction showed degradations; D1 'Moderate' drought (D1) and 'Abnormally Dry' (D0, not yet drought) coverage expanded across northern Louisiana and a new D0 area appeared in southwestern Louisiana
- 'Dry' and 'Very Dry' conditions are now reported by most LSU AgCenter field agents across the state; only a handful of parish agents are reporting 'Near Normal' conditions, nearly 2/3rds noted that conditions had 'Slightly' or 'Significantly' degraded in their parish during the period
- as of August 03, the USDA noted 'Adequate' or 'Surplus' topsoil and subsoil conditions for 38% and 37% of the state, respectively; pasture and range conditions were noted as 'Fair', 'Good', or 'Excellent' for all but 12% of Louisiana
- as of August 4, three parishes in northern Louisiana had recently enacted Burn Bans while Parish Fire Danger levels are now listed as 'Very High' or 'High' for the majority of monitored parishes



Severe/Stormy Weather:

It was a relatively quiet 7-day period in terms of severe weather. Heat was the main story during the first three days of the stretch as all four NWS offices supporting the state issued *Heat Advisories* for both July 29 & July 30, additional *Heat Advisories* were issued by the Jackson and Shreveport offices for July 31. An *Extreme Heat Warning* was issued for areas surrounding lakes Pontchartrain and Maurepas on July 29. Not all locations within the advised/warned areas achieved Heat Index values at or above advisory/warning criteria; however, conditions were hot and humid enough to increase heat stress.

A front entered the state on August 1st but was a mainly dry passage until the morning of the 2nd. Showers and thunderstorms increased across southeastern Louisiana and prompted the only severe weather *Warning* during the 7-day stretch, a *Flash Flood Warning* for Assumption Parish. The *LSRs* show flash flooding reports in the Napoleonville & Pierre Part areas and a wind damage report near New Orleans that morning.
